Guide to our Charges

To make costs as clear as possible we have created a 'guide to our charges' which describes in full the cost of our services. This guide includes the CMA Standardised Price List, our Additional options price list and various 'tailored funerals' at a set cost. Each of which will be offered to clients leaving you to choose which best fits their wishes and circumstances.

All estimates will itemise all our costs based on the choices made and include any 'Disbursement costs' (third party charges)

Disbursements

Disbursements are payments that have to be made by the funeral director to third parties who are supplying a service which has been chosen out with our cost. These may include

- Cemetery or Crematorium costs
 - Floral Tributes
- Obituaries in local or national newspapers
 - Clergy/Officiant fee
- Webcasts, visual tribute and slideshows

Payment Terms

1. We require an advanced payment of £1000 towards Third Party Fees (Disbursements) to be paid no later than 72hrs before arrange funeral date

**Note - In some cases this may be increased E.G. large bespoke funerals or where the clients fails to confirm how payment of the account will be made*

2. Remaining balances on invoices are payable within 28 days of the scheduled funeral date

3. Overdue invoices can be subject to a late fee of 1.5% (above base lending rate) along with any fees incurred from our solicitors to recover any debits

STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only) £2315.00

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care	£200.00

Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from cherry wood veneer with flat lid and sides including handles	£410.00
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)	£25.00
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£530.00

UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial (funeral director's charges only) £1300.00

Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee)² £1360.00

FEES YOU MUST PAY

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee.¹ **£1056.95 - £2170.75**

In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is: **£1056.95**

For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.

For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee.² **£600.00 - £1029.00**

In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is: **£1029.00**

¹ This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
